What is the Fed Challenge?

Every year since 2004, The Federal Reserve Bank holds a competition to promote college students' understanding of the FRB system and monetary policy. Our team, consisting of 5 speakers and 5 researchers, will compete in early November against other teams in our region. All students who have taken Eco 1 and either Eco 29 or 119 are welcome to interview to be on Lehigh's team.

Fed Challenge is a 200-level economics course, which can be counted toward the economics major and can be repeated in the future. Students with research roles will receive one credit, students with research roles repeating the course will receive two credits, and students with speaking roles will receive three credits.
